MICHIGAN PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT RULES VFW 4357 - Brighton

- 1. The Michigan Progressive Jackpot bingo game shall only be played on disposable bingo cards which shall be color or design the licensee does not use for any other game.
- 2. All bingo cards sold for the Progressive Jackpot game shall be sold for a uniform price. There shall be **no discount** for the purchase of more than one card (this includes books, pads, packets, or other combinations of cards offered on a book).
- 3. All bingo cards used in the Michigan Progressive shall be sold prior to the 5th game.
- 4. The Michigan Progressive Jackpot game is a coverall only. No other combinations or games will be allowed.
- 5. The Michigan Progressive Jackpot prize shall be paid by check. Cash or check can be used to pay the consolation prize.
- 6. The consolation prize shall not be paid from the 50% of the card sales used to fund The Michigan Progressive Jackpot game.
- 7. The bingo caller will announce the amount of the jackpot, the number of calls needed to win before the game begins. The caller will announce during the game when the jackpot numbers have ended and the consolation numbers begin.
- 8. The amount of the jackpot carried over from the previous week, the numbers needed to win, and the amount of the jackpot is going for that week will be posted for everyone to see.
- 9. The first week will have 50 numbers called to be a good coverall for the \$400 prize. If no one has a bingo in the 50 numbers, there will be a consolation prize of \$100.
- 10. Each week one number will be added to the 50 numbers, as well as 50% of the Progressive jackpot card sales added to the previous jackpot, until a bingo coverall is awarded.
- 11. Each week the jackpot is not awarded a consolation prize of \$100 will be awarded.
- 12. When the jackpot is awarded there will not be a consolation prize.
