Rules

- 1. A regular BINGO is any horizontal, vertical, diagonal line, four corners, top and bottom "V".
- 2. You must be 18 years of age to play BINGO.
- 3. You must have a valid admission stub, visible at all times, and play only the amount of cards listed on your stub.
- **4.** You must have all cards selected before the first number is called in a given game. Selecting or switching of cards or a card after the first number is called, will make all of your cards invalid for that game.
- 5. Extra cards must be removed from the tables. If you are unable to do so, please ask a worker to do it.
- 6. A player must have the last number called to have a valid BINGO.
- 7. It's the responsibility of the player to make their BINGO known. Only the caller or a worker can verify and confirm a BINGO.
- 8. You must play your own cards and specials. Workers may play your cards, but **are not** responsible for missing a BINGO.
- 9. No seats may be saved.
- 10. Players must purchase their own cards unless player is disabled or if standing in line would present a hardship.
- **11.** Profanity or harassment of workers will not be permitted.
- **12.** All other State of Michigan BINGO rules apply.
- **13**. Comments, suggestions, and ideas on our games are welcome. Please submit them on your admission stub and hand it to a worker after the last game.
- **14.** You may have more than one BINGO on the same card, on the same number.
